



4) Achievements of being VP Community '10/'11 vs Manifesto 2010

This year I have achieved and surpassed last year's manifesto by: implementing HUU:TV (www.huutv.co.uk), representing you on issues you voted for in the NSS & Redbrick Research, implementing the Societies Award so you know who the best societies are – an award which has now been taken up nationally by the NUS, commissioned Hullfire to do research, and overseen its change to a newspaper, encouraging JamRadio to do more outside broadcasts which has seen them at all major HUU events including the national demo in London, pushed RAG to surpass the total money raised in the whole of last year by the first semester this year and put them on track to raise a record breaking £30,000 in total this year, attended 100% of local ward forums – representing your issues, worked with the BBC Candlelight Appeal on a brand new major community event, secured a bike lock loan system, implemented the John Bernasconi Award, increased Society membership to 2000+ and held the most successful societies fayre ever amongst others.
