- ❖ Clearer and concise information and support services for students
 - Support for certain mitigating circumstances

 - More financial support and cheaper services
 - More and cheaper housing
 - Creating more awareness about health issues and collaborating with NHS

 - Black History Month to be bigger and better
 - Collaborate with societies
 - Work with RAG to raise money for charities such as LCD
 - Work with HUUTV, Jam Radio and Hull Fire to raise awareness
 - Have events throughout the month – once or twice a week
 - Accommodation – is Taylor Court increasing segregation?
- ❖ Stop discrimination against disabled students; create awareness of unseen disabilities and mental health issues
 - Especially focusing on the awareness of unseen disabilities and mental health
 - Arrange a walk around Hull to raise money and awareness (placards)
 - Make sure all disabled students are aware of what different disabilities are recognised as
 - Making the entire campus disability friendly
- ❖ Creating an online anonymous support system for victims of bullying, harassment and racism
 - Having different sub groups – LGBT, Women's issues, Racism, disabilities and others
- ❖ Increase awareness of the different issues affecting Student Life by organising a variety of awareness weeks and events such as SHAG week, BHM, Earth Day, Interfaith Week and LGBT History Month.
